then three days later he came back to life.

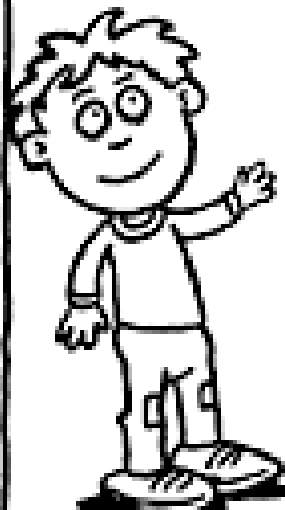
Then he went back to heaven.

He took your sins and died in your place.

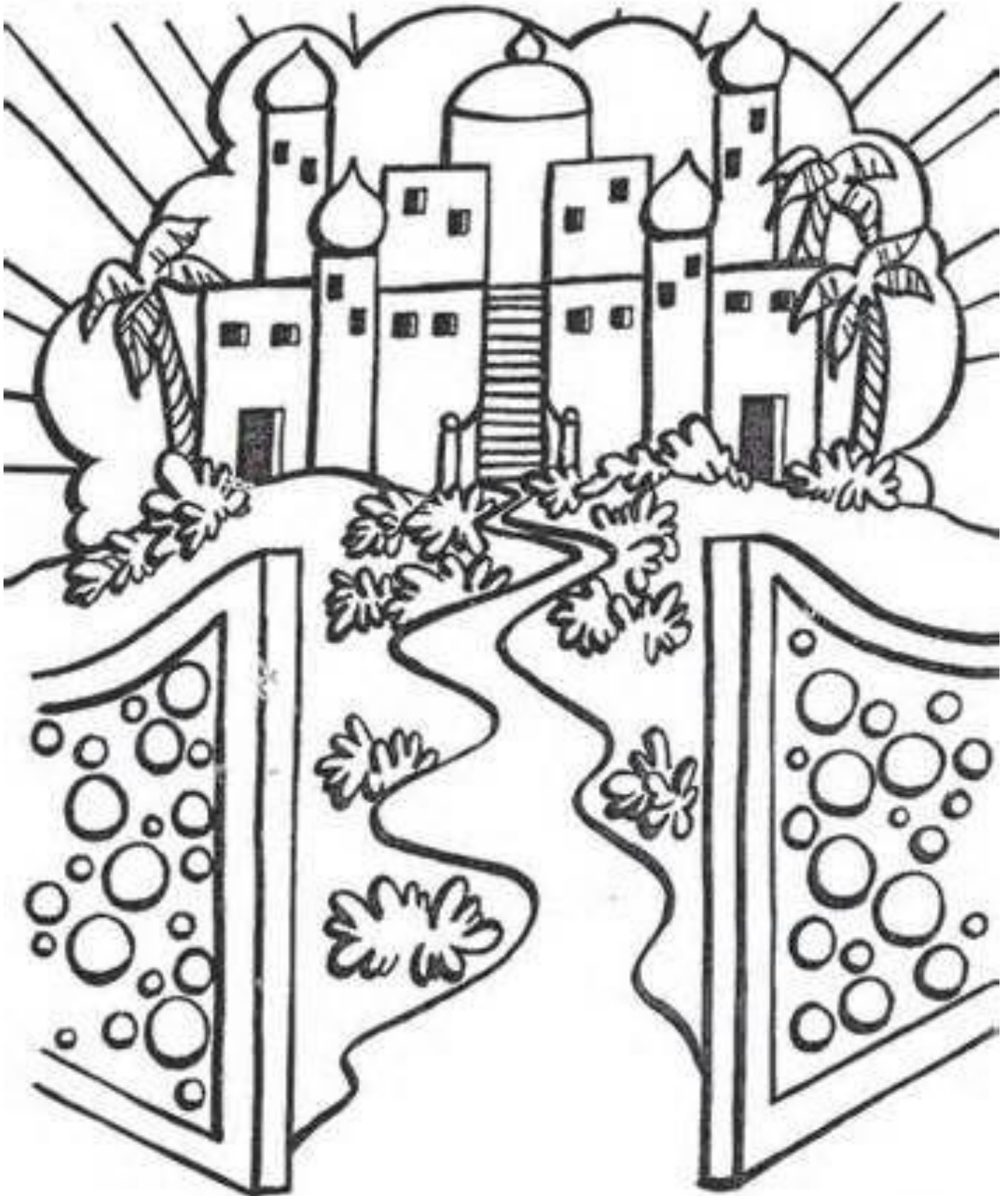
The third thing to do is follow Jesus.
