Enjoy selecting an activity to do at home by asking your parents to print out the activity which you would like to do. Have fun. Can you make a rainbow?



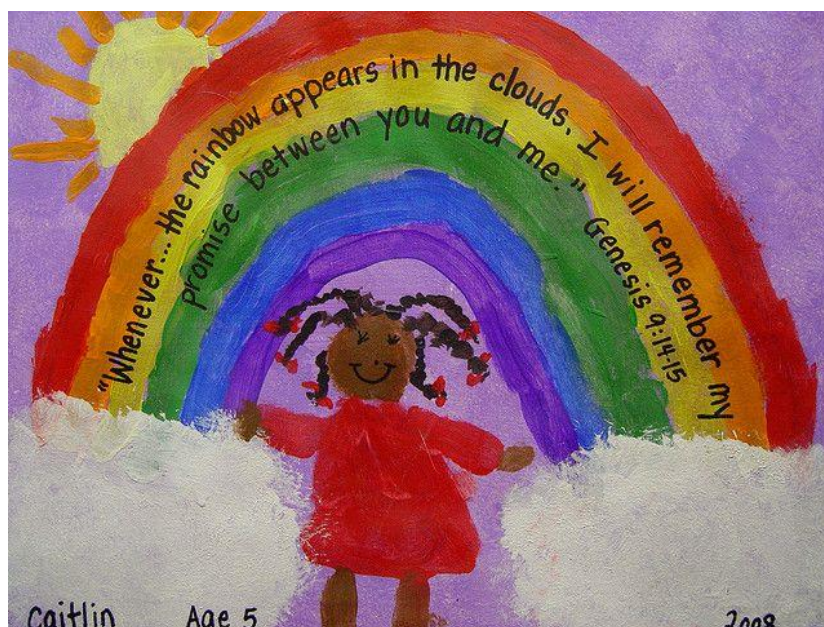

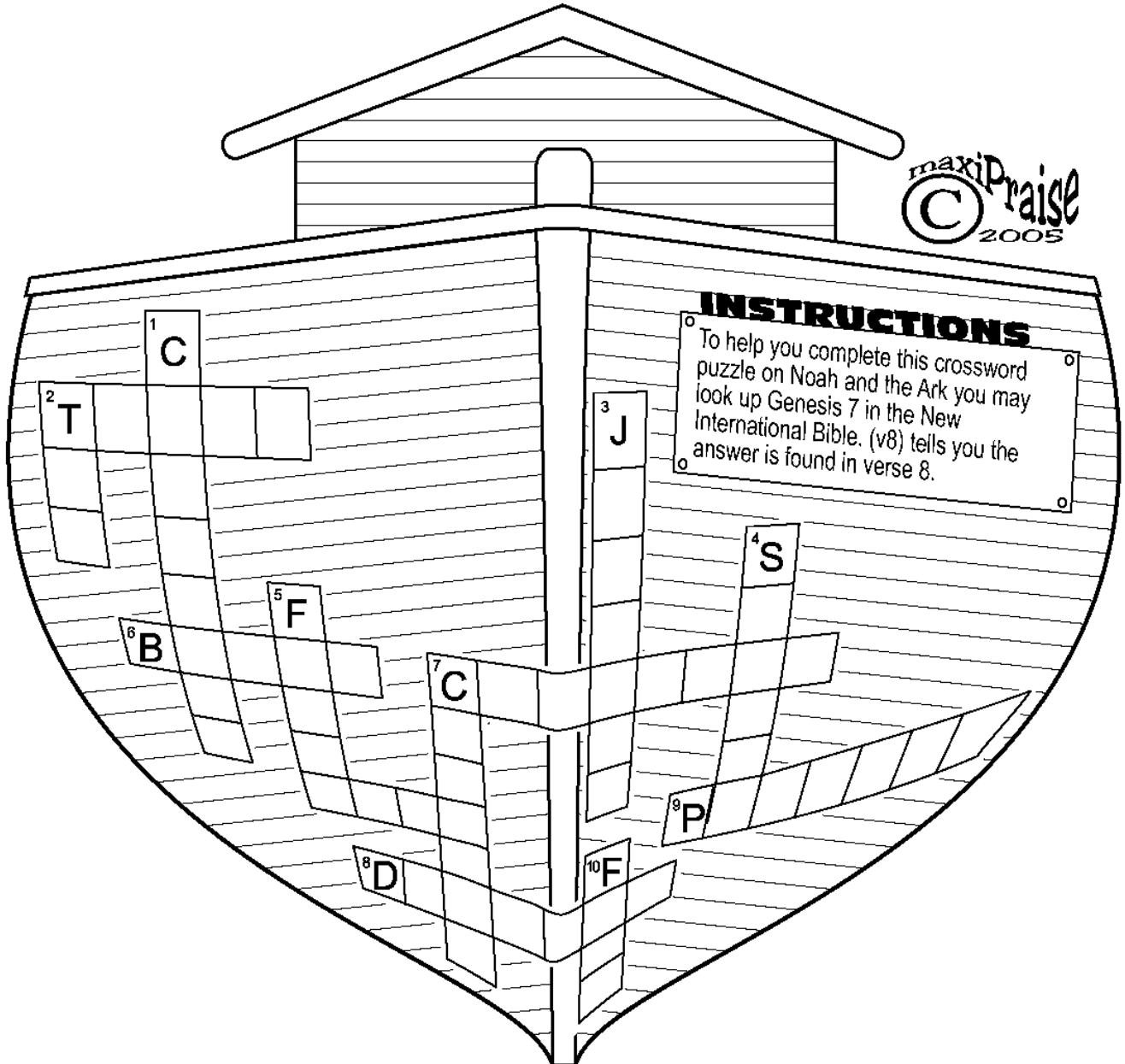

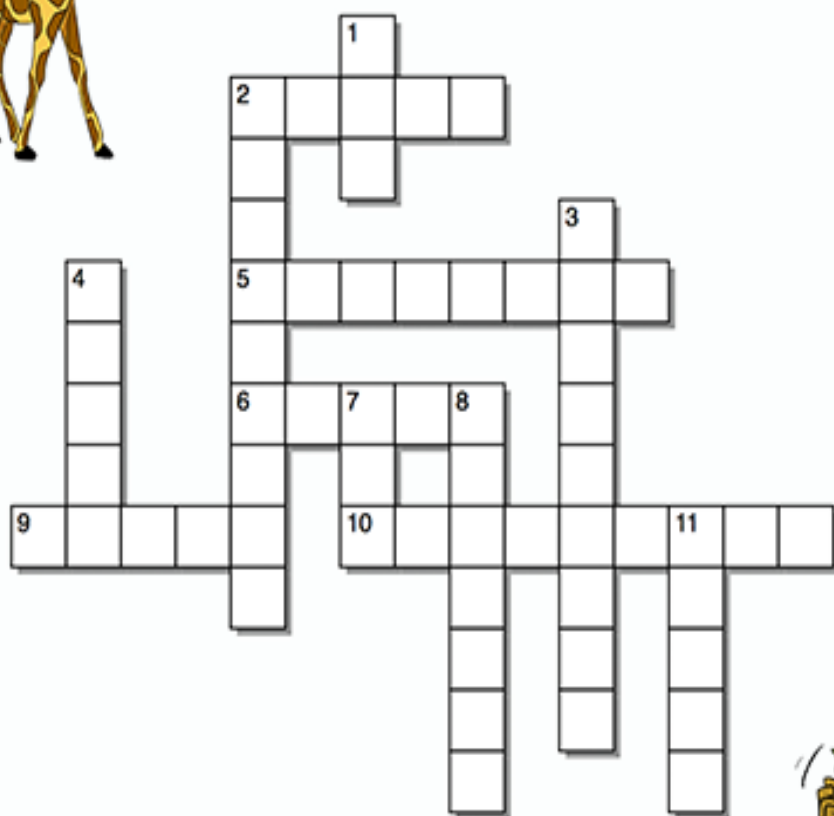
