Acts 16:25-26

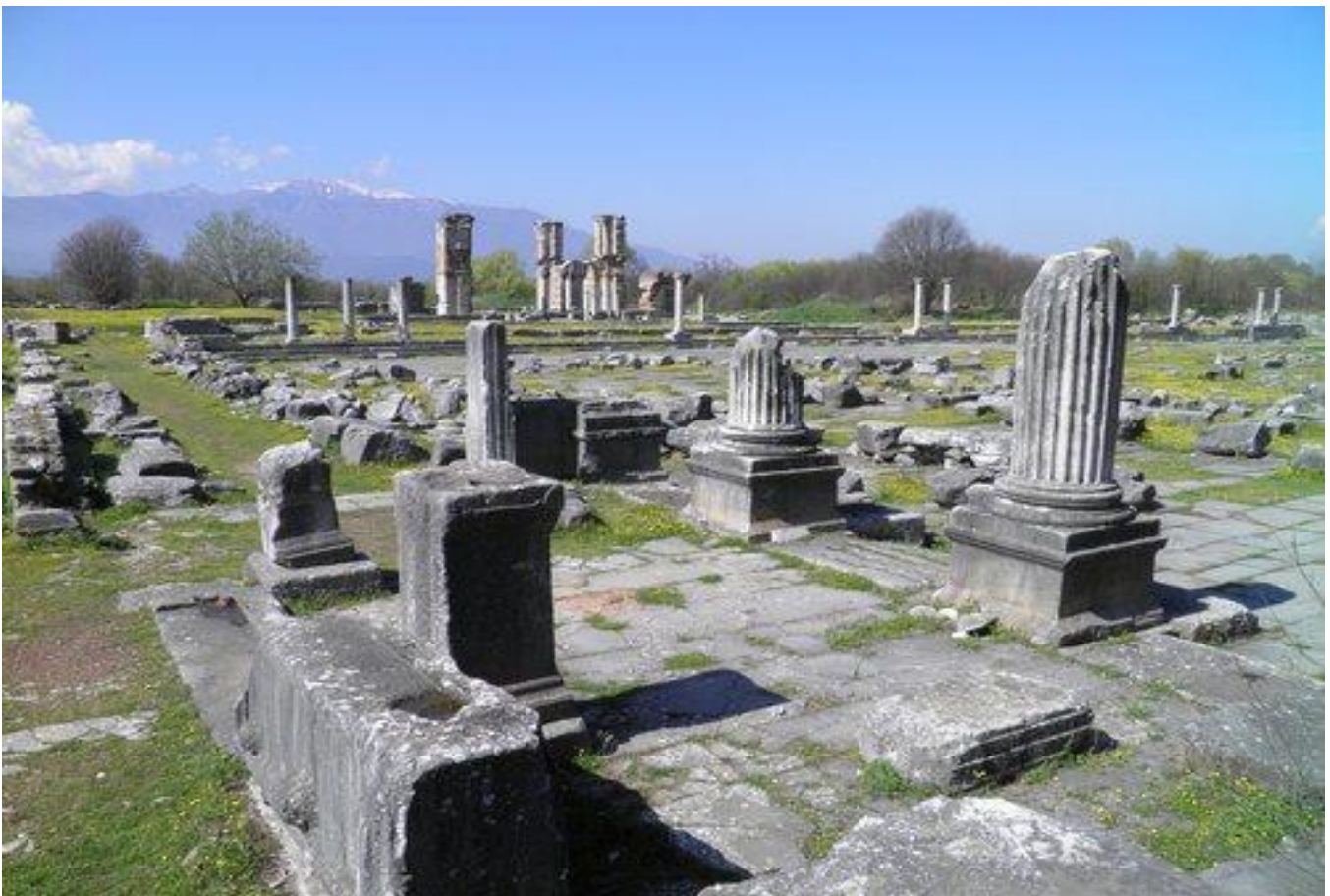


Act it out DRAMA !!!

The Earthquake at the Philippian Jail

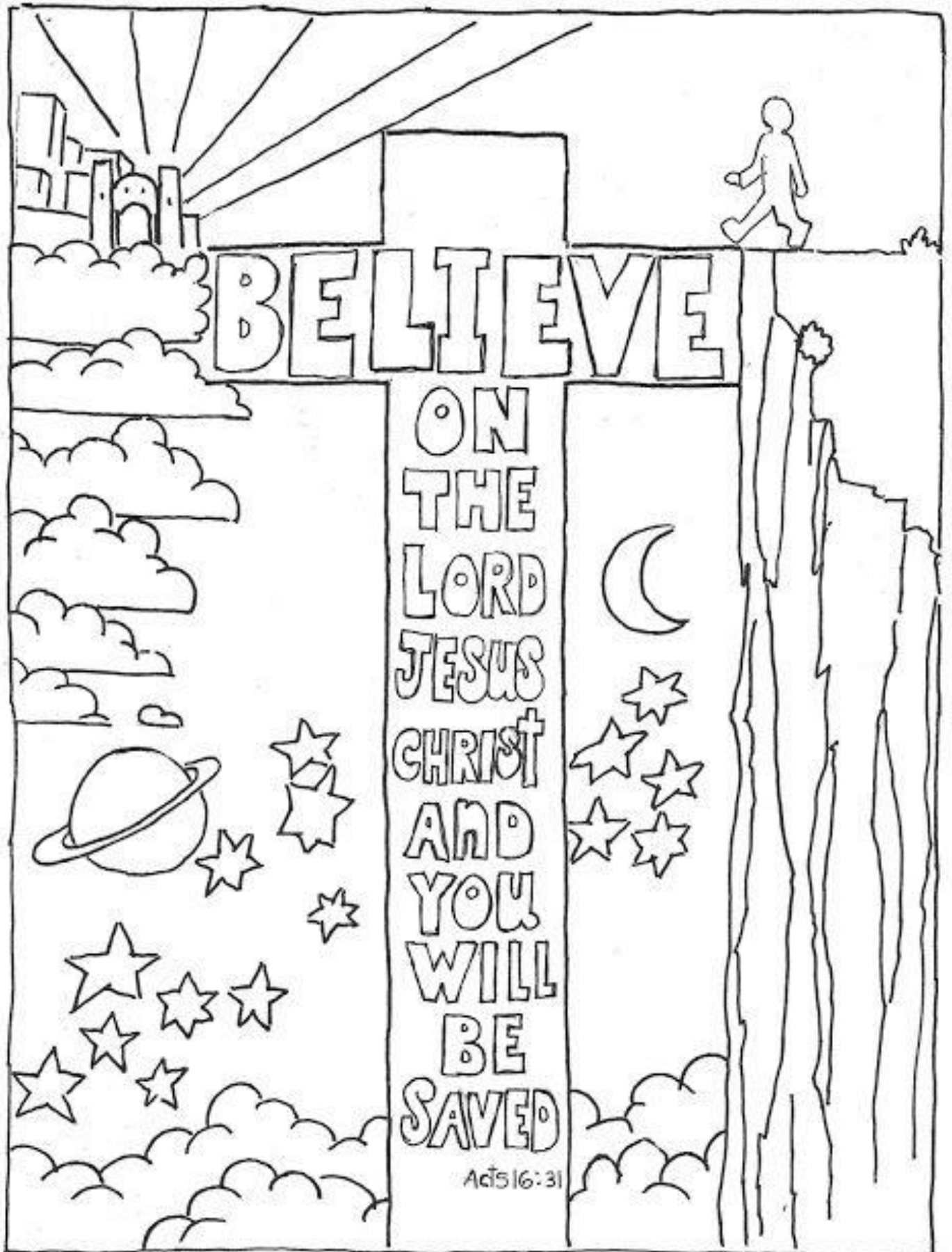

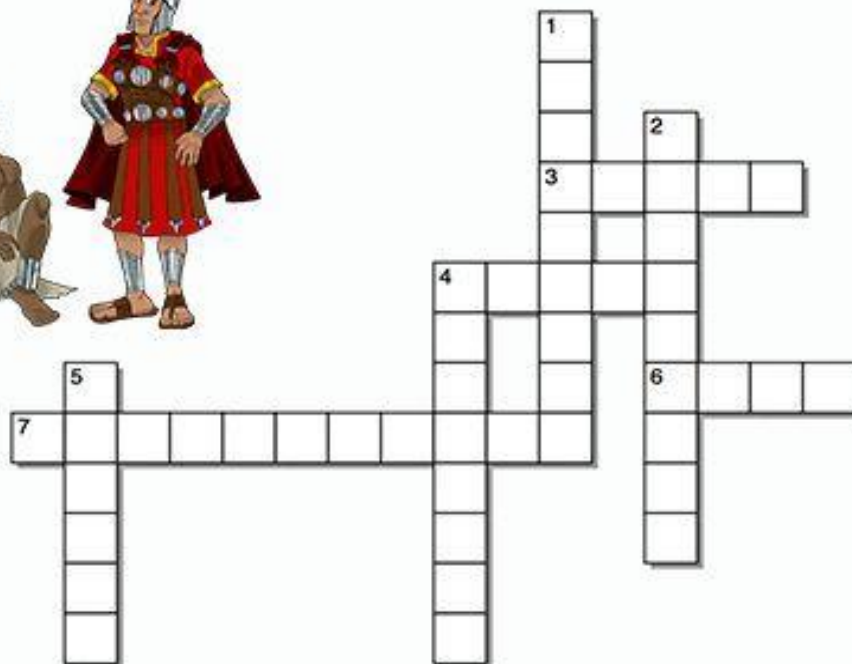
