LET YOUR KINGDOM COME


Your glorious cause O God

1 Timothy 2:1-8

RETURNING TO SUNG WORSHIP IN CHURCH

During the covid lockdowns, many of us have become accustomed to virtual worship. This format was interestingly different. For instance the television-style bible teaching facilitated a smooth and powerful integration of power-point and graphics into the teaching of God's word. The virtual sung worship also included a wider range of Christ-centred modern songs. At home we were able to sing-along with these songs, with absolutely no inhibitions about our neighbours in the next bubble hearing our wrong notes or incorrect rhythms, just singing great words to the greater glory of God.

In the virtual worship we were singing along to recordings, with superb lead singers and professional Christian bands. Most of these songs were written to be led by a singer and band, rather than just a piano. With the progressive easing of lockdown, we are returning to real services in the Church buildings and hope to be able to sing again in the church buildings. We can begin singing to recordings, but from the beginning of the September term, we will try to reform a church band, able to assist the singing of some of the new songs we have learned during lockdown.

We know that many of our congregation have musical skills. Remember that playing in a band is easier than solo performances. Ideally we need one or more lead singers, a drummer, rhythm and bass guitar, and keyboard players. Also orchestral instruments can play an extremely useful role - Dennis Willetts
