The next All Age Worship Service will be on Sunday 13th April, 10am.

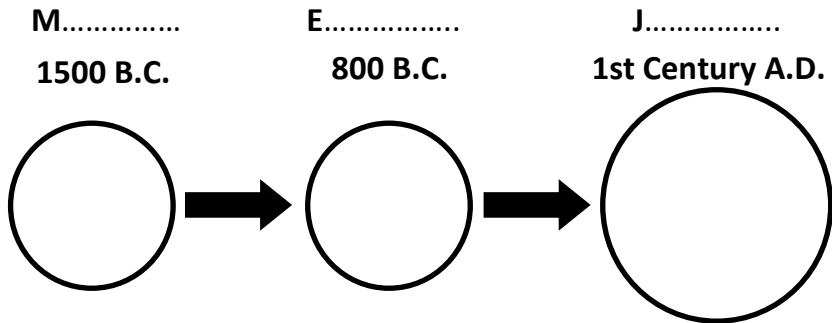
