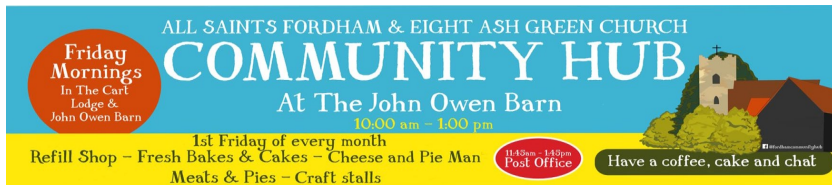
CHURCH DIARY

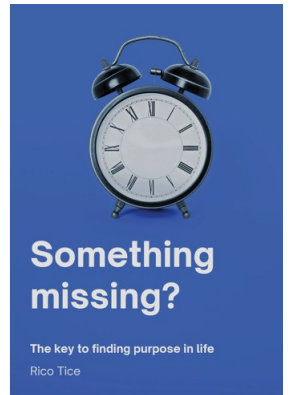
