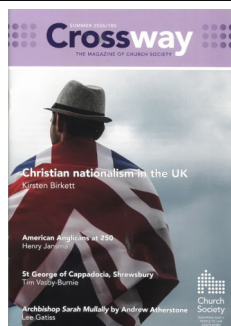
For the last 2 years FACT has participated in the London 2 Brighton cycle ride with a team of around 28 cyclists. It is a wonderful day and our team has raised over £22,000 for our bursary fund. This fund ensures that no child is ever left behind due to family financial constraints. Last year, the fund distributed over £30,000, helping 354 children attend FACT with their school, church or youth group. FACT gives young people life changing adventures. Since the pandemic many of those who come to us have never stayed away from home before or tried many of the activities we offer: sailing, kayaking, power boating, high ropes, climbing wall, crabbing, team games and environmental studies. www.fact.org.uk
